RACV Goldfields Super6 Tournament format

Tournament Overview

The RACV Goldfields Super6 is a fully sanctioned event by the PGA and forms part of the Ladbrokes PGA Pro-Am series.

Amateurs will have the chance to play with a number of leading PGA Professionals across two exciting days of competition. Day 1 will be an 18 hole Individual Stableford competition with the top 24 players progressing to Day 2 a 6 hole match play knockout series.

The winner of the inaugural RACV Goldfields Super6 (amateur) will win their way through to play in the Victorian PGA Celebrity Challenge run in conjunction with the Victorian PGA Championship to be held at RACV Cape Schanck Resort in October.

Players will also compete for a share in over \$1,500 worth of the latest gear from Callaway.



Qualifying Round

Amateurs will have the chance to play alongside up to two PGA Professionals in an 18 hole Individual Stableford round.

Date: Saturday 20 January 2018

Tee Times: either 7.30am or 12.30pm shotgun start

Competition: 18 hole Individual Stableford

Entry: **\$129 per player.**

- Play alongside a PGA Professional
- Breakfast & lunch (am players) or lunch & cocktail function during presentations (pm players)
- Prizes and giveaways



Cut and seedings

The top 24 Individual Stableford scores from the Saturday qualifying round will progress to the Sunday match play competition.

Ties: Should more than one player tie for any position within the 24 places there will be a countback to break these ties. The system used for the countback shall be last 9 holes, last 6 holes, last 3 holes, then hole by hole from the 18th.

Seedings: Players will then be seeded from highest qualifier (1) to last qualifier (24). The above countback method will be applied to break any ties.



Match play competition

Qualifying amateurs will compete in a 6 hole match play series on Sunday the 21st of January. Amateurs will compete alongside two PGA Professionals

Date: Sunday 20 January 2018

Competition: 6 hole handicap match play.

Handicaps: Players will be allocated 1/3 of their applicable daily handicap.

Hole Index: All matches will be played according to the match play index (see Courses)

Ties: Should a match be tied after 6 holes, players will proceed to the "Shootout Hole" for a sudden death playoff. If after the 1st sudden death hole scores remain tied players will return to the "Shootout Hole" tee for a Nearest the Pin Competition to decide the winner. No handicap is applied.
